UniversityOfWaterloo - Captive Portal (Guest Wi-Fi)

Guests at the University can register for a Wi-Fi account on the UniversityOfWaterloo wireless network. Upon connecting to the network, clients will be forwarded to a captive portal page where they can set up an account and acknowledge the guideline on the use of computing and network resources (S Guidelines on use of Waterloo computing and network resources | Information Systems & Technology). Accounts are valid for 16 days before requiring re-registration.
